



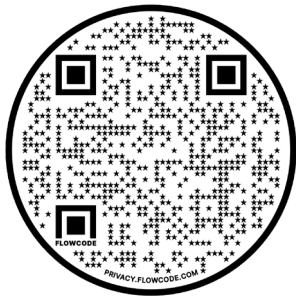

First of Its Kind Data Project!

The Arizona Physical Education Data Project uses K-12 State Longitudinal Data Systems (SLDS) and other State DOE data sets on an annual basis. The project is led by Quadrant Research and The Arizona Department of Education. Arizona is the first state in the Nation to participate in the Physical Education Data Project that includes:

- Interactive Dashboards
- Key Findings Data Report
- County Enrollment Identifiers
- Key Demographic Identifiers including Race, Gender, Free and Reduced Lunch Percentages, and Special Education

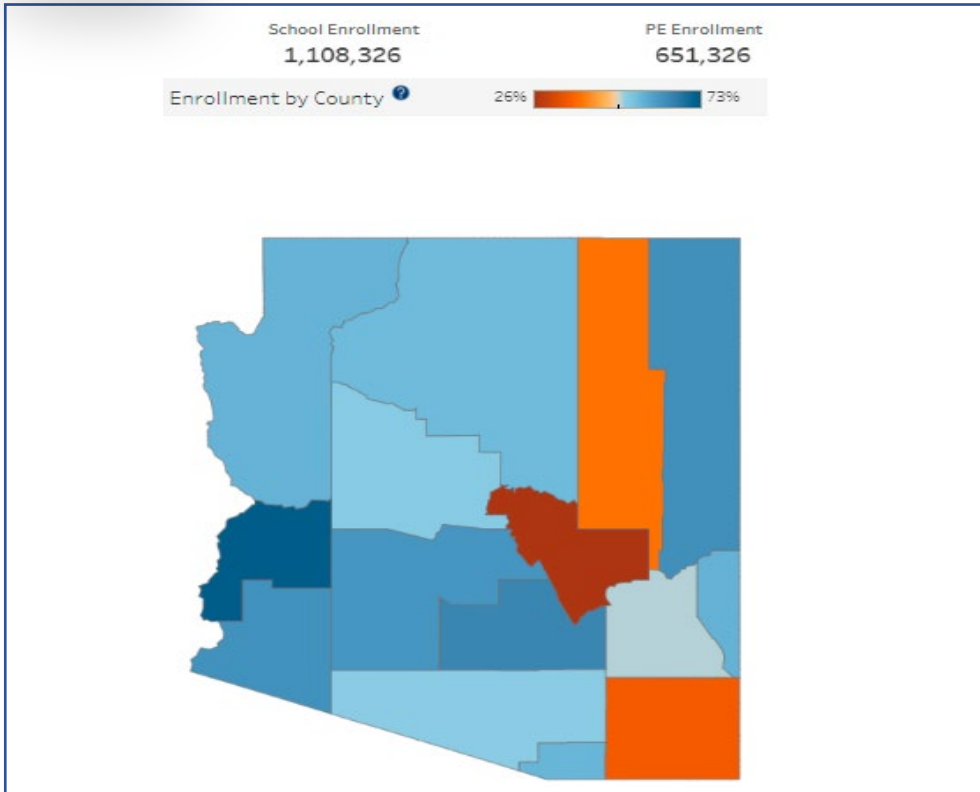
